JAMES T. ROSENBAUM, MD

Known and respected throughout the world as a brilliant thought leader in the field of rheumatology and ocular immunology, Dr. Rosenbaum is currently the Edward E. Rosenbaum Professor of Inflammatory Diseases, Chair, Division of Arthritis and Rheumatic Diseases, Professor of Ophthalmology, Medicine and Cell Biology, and Director, Inflammation Research at the Oregon Health & Science University. He is also the Chief of Ophthalmology (Emeritus) and holds the Richard Chenoweth Chair (Emeritus) at the Devers Eye Institute ... being the only known rheumatologist in the world who has ever led an eye institute!

Dr. Rosenbaum graduated from Lincoln High School in Portland, Oregon where he was a National Merit Scholar, and obtained his Bachelor of Arts from Harvard College in 1971, followed by a Doctor of Medicine degree from Yale in 1975. Subsequently, he came to Stanford where he completed his internship and residency in Internal Medicine, as well as a fellowship with the Arthritis Foundation in the Division of Immunology at Stanford.

Internationally, Dr. Rosenbaum is recognized for his description of an animal model of uveitis) resulting from injection of bacterial endotoxin and for many landmark publications, mostly related to the intersection between rheumatology and ophthalmology

Throughout his career, Dr. Rosenbaum has garnered many, many honours and awards, including the Dolly Green Scholar Award from Research to Prevent Blindness, the American College of Rheumatology Distinguished Clinician Scholar Award, the Canadian Rheumatology Association, Dunlop Dottridge Lectureship, and the International Uveitis Study Group Foundation Gold Medal, among many others.

Professor Rosenbaum has contributed significantly toward the understanding of the ocular immune system and what may result when there are over-actions or underactions of immunologic pathways leading to immunopathology of ocular diseases. With over 550 manuscripts published in peer-reviewed journals representing his work in both basic and clinical science, and many book chapters as well as organizer and session chair and visiting lecturer over hundreds of congresses, Dr. Rosenbaum is truly one of the greats in medicine, rheumatology, and ophthalmology, having contributed extensively to the understanding of ocular diseases.

In addition, Dr. Rosenbaum is truly a master in teaching, having served as visiting professors and lecturers at hundreds of universities, symposia, workshops, sharing his knowledge with others across the globe and enhancing the understanding of ocular immunologic diseases.

However, despite his many successes and international fame, among his most accomplished achievements is his mentorship and teaching of many students, residents, fellows, and young faculty members in the United States and around the world over the years to help them in their academic careers.

Professor Rosenbaum symbolizes an ideal model of a scientist and public servant – one who dedicates a lifetime to providing better knowledge of the role of inflammation in ocular diseases and to training the next generations of clinician scientists in the fields of rheumatology and ocular immunology.
